Harrisburg, PA (October 2, 2020) – On Saturday, October 3, the fight for racial justice will continue as regional community leaders across the state gather on the steps of the State Capitol at 1:00 p.m. They will be rallying to mobilize voters to participate in this year's election based on issues that demand justice and accountability.

The "We Can't Wait" campaign launched by the PA Statewide Coalition in August, takes its inspiration from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his example of mobilizing peaceful civil disobedience in Alabama. His letter, written in Birmingham jail, expressing the inability for his oppressed people to wait for justice any longer, is still relevant more than 60 years later. Just like Dr. King, this collective is standing resolute in the face of oppositional leadership in Harrisburg knowing that there is no greater moment than now to STAND UP!

The two hour event will combine musical performances from the Birmingham Freedom Movement and Haibun style speeches that will personify the perilous plights of local Pennsylvania communities.
